ITINERARY DETAILS

Day 1: Byzantine & Ottoman Wonders

> Day 2: Palaces & Bazaars

- Guided tour of Hagia Sophia: Marvel at this 1,500-yearold architectural marvel, where Byzantine mosaics blend with Islamic calligraphy under a soaring dome that redefined sacred space.
- Visit the Blue Mosque: Step into Istanbul's iconic mosque, adorned with 20,000 hand-painted Iznik tiles and bathed in the soft glow of 260 stained-glass windows.
- Explore the Basilica Cistern: Wander through this subterranean palace of 336 marble columns, where Medusa-head pillars and eerie lighting create an atmosphere of mystery.
- Tour Topkapı Palace: Delve into the opulent world of Ottoman sultans in their former residence, treasury (home to the 86-carat Spoonmaker's Diamond), and Harem's gilded chambers.
- Get lost in the Grand Bazaar: Navigate 4,000 shops in this labyrinthine market, bargaining for spices, lanterns, and Turkish carpets amid the scent of apple tea.
- Sunset at Süleymaniye Mosque: Climb the terrace for panoramic views of the Golden Horn, then step inside Sinan's masterpiece, where light filters through Ottoman stained glass.

Day 3: Bosphorus & Beyoğlu

- Dolmabahçe Palace tour: Walk the 4.5-ton crystal chandelier-lit halls where Atatürk spent his final days, then stroll the palace gardens along the European shoreline.
- Galata Tower ascent: Climb this 14th-century Genoese tower for 360° views, then explore bohemian cafés in the artsy Karaköy district below.

- Scenic ferry-bus transfer to Bursa: Watch the Sea of Marmara sparkle as you journey to Turkey's first Ottoman capital.
- Explore Koza Han: Sit under mulberry trees in this 15th-century silk market, sipping tea while vendors unfurl shimmering scarves.
- Dine on Iskender Kebab: Taste Bursa's famed dish -succulent lamb over pita, drowned in browned butter and yogurt—at its birthplace, Kebapcı İskender.
- Odunpazarı district stroll: Snap photos of candycolored Ottoman houses turned into art galleries and café courtvards.
- Sazova Park: Ride a mini-train past storybook castles and pirate ships in this whimsical park.
- Evening gondola ride: Drift along the Porsuk River, passing lively student cafés in Turkey's "Little Venice."
- Uchisar Castle viewpoint: Watch sunset paint the valley's fairy chimneys gold from this rock-cut fortress.
- Göreme Open-Air Museum: Step into Byzantine cave churches like the Dark Church, where 11th-century frescoes glow under LED lights.
- Descend into Derinkuyu: Crouch through tunnels in this 18-level underground city where early Christians hid from invaders.
- ATV tour through Rose Valley: Kick up dust as you zip past vineyards and rock-cut dovecotes at golden hour.
- Overnight drive to Bursa: Sleep in reclining seats as starry plains flash by.
- Morning thermal spa revival: Soak away travel fatigue before your final Istanbul transfer.

- 09:00-12:00 Rüstem Pasha Mosque & Multi-Faith Discovery
 - Marvel at this hidden 16th-century gem, famed for its exquisite tulip-patterned İznik tiles.
 - Walk the Golden Horn's historic lanes, visiting the Greek Orthodox Patriarchate, Ahrida Synagogue, and the Iron Church.
- 15:00-17:30 Pierre Loti Hill & Eyüp District
 - Sip Turkish coffee with panoramic Golden Horn views.
 - Descend by cable car through Ottoman-era cemeteries.
- Evening Options (Choose One)
 - Option 1: Kumkapı Meyhane Night (For lively groups)
 - 19:00-22:00 Farewell Feast at a Historic Tavern
 - Dine on 20+ meze dishes in a 150-year-old meyhane.
 - Live fasıl music (violin, oud, darbuka) with singing and dancing.
 - Toast with rakı amid Kumkapı's bustling fish-market energy.
 - Best for: Travelers craving an authentic, festive Istanbul finale.
 - Option 2: Bosphorus Moonlight Cruise (For relaxed groups)
 - 19:00-22:00 Private Yacht Dinner
 - Glide past illuminated palaces and bridges.
 - Savor meze and grilled seafood on deck.

 - Best for: Couples or those preferring a serene farewell.
