Day 1: Byzantine & Ottoman Wonders

> Day 2: Palaces & Bazaars

• Guided tour of Hagia Sophia: Marvel at this 1,500year-old architectural marvel, where Byzantine mosaics blend with Islamic calligraphy under a soaring dome that redefined sacred space.

- Visit the Blue Mosque: Step into Istanbul's iconic mosque, adorned with 20,000 hand-painted Iznik tiles and bathed in the soft glow of 260 stained-glass windows.
- Explore the Basilica Cistern: Wander through this subterranean palace of 336 marble columns, where Medusa-head pillars and eerie lighting create an atmosphere of mystery.
- Tour Topkapı Palace: Delve into the opulent world of Ottoman sultans in their former residence, treasury (home to the 86-carat Spoonmaker's Diamond), and Harem's gilded chambers.
- Get lost in the Grand Bazaar: Navigate 4,000 shops in this labyrinthine market, bargaining for spices, lanterns, and Turkish carpets amid the scent of apple tea.
- Sunset at Süleymaniye Mosque: Climb the terrace for panoramic views of the Golden Horn, then step inside Sinan's masterpiece, where light filters through Ottoman stained glass.

Day 3: Bosphorus & Beyoğlu

- Dolmabahçe Palace tour: Walk the 4.5-ton crystal chandelier-lit halls where Atatürk spent his final days, then stroll the palace gardens along the European shoreline.
- Galata Tower ascent: Climb this 14th-century Genoese tower for 360° views, then explore bohemian cafés in the artsy Karaköy district below.

- Scenic ferry-bus transfer to Bursa: Watch the Sea of Marmara sparkle as you journey to Turkey's first Ottoman capital.
- Explore Koza Han: Sit under mulberry trees in this 15th-century silk market, sipping tea while vendors unfurl shimmering scarves.
- Dine on Iskender Kebab: Taste Bursa's famed dish —succulent lamb over pita, drowned in browned butter and yogurt—at its birthplace, Kebapçı İskender.
- Visit the Green Mosque & Tomb: Admire the emerald-green tiles and intricate arabesques of this early Ottoman gem.
- Cable car to Uludağ: Soar above pine forests to Turkey's legendary ski resort (2,300m), hiking to glacial lakes in summer or sipping salep by firepits in winter.
- Relax in a Çelik Palas thermal bath: Soak in 40°C mineral waters where Atatürk once took the cure, beneath a 1920s stained-glass dome.
- Walk cobbled streets of Cumalıkızık: Photograph pastel Ottoman houses, then buy homemade jams from villagers in this UNESCO-listed hamlet.
- Tophane viewpoint: Pause for a final Bursa panorama before your VAN returns to Istanbul.
- Departure prep, airport transfer
