- Trek through alpine meadows to a shepherd's hut (1.5 hours moderate walk) with panoramic valley views

- Firtina Valley Bridges Ottoman-era stone arches over turquoise rapids

- Ayder Plateau Thermal Baths
- Soak in 40°C mineral pools surrounded by cloudforest
- Honey Tasting at a local yayla (mountain pasture)
- Evening:
- Check-in to Rize's tea plantation guesthouse
- Overnight: Rize

- İyidere Tea Factory Tour
- Witness the journey from leaf to cup in Turkey's tea heartland
- Tea Garden Experience
- Sip freshly brewed çay while learning the "kıtlama" sugar ritual from local experts

- Visit this 6th-century Georgian cliff monastery overlooking the sea

- Explore Trabzon's old town with its Byzantine-era streets

- Farewell dinner featuring Akçaabat köfte (spiced meatballs)
- Overnight: Trabzon city hotel

- A peaceful morning walk around this crater lake surrounded by hydrangeas
